The main strategic goal of the Association is the full-scale expansion of consumption of the domestic aluminium and aluminium-containing products by all industrial sectors.

In this regard, the Association focuses on improving the regulatory and technical base, protecting the domestic market from counterfeit products and dumping imports, as well as deepening the cross-sectoral cooperation that fosters the use of aluminium solutions in various sectors of the economy.

Today, more than 120 companies-members of the Aluminium Association account for over 70% of all high-value-added aluminium production.

Metef the international exhibition on aluminium, metal foundry and technologies for innovative materials, was launched in Italy in 1997 as the first expo worldwide dedicated to aluminium.

The last edition of Metef hosted 400 exhibiting companies and over 11,000 specialized operators, 40% of which came from 63 foreign countries.

Metef is a meeting point for all the operators in the aluminium and metal specialty production chains who are interested in their specific segments: Production - Converting and intermediate processing - Recovery and recycling.

SespeL's products are exported to Russia, Belarus, Kazakhstan and Uzbekistan.
